Draft Minutes of Meeting held 7th July 2021 – Chop Gate Village Hall

1. Apologies for absence received from County Cllr B Griffiths, District Cllrs R Kirk, and R Hudson and Parish Councillors Frank Auffret and Marc Roberts
2. Newly appointed Parish Councillors Frank Auffret and Marc Roberts could not attend the meeting so declarations could not be signed. RESOLVED – declarations will be signed at the next meeting.
3. Declarations of personal or prejudicial interest – none declared
4. The minutes of the meeting held on 5th May 2021 were agreed as a true and correct record
5. Police report: No police report to present.
6. NYMNP planning applications –

NYM/2021/0342/CLE Fangdale Beck Farm – lawfulness of animal shelters, it was confirmed that the Parish council had no comments on the application of established use.
NYM/2021/0365/FL Fangdale Beck Farm – retrospective application of animal shelters and shed, it was confirmed that the Parish Council had no objections.

It was noted that the Parish Council comments had not been made public on the NYMNP website and that this had been rectified and confirmed by the planning department.

7. Verge cutting –
It was confirmed that a tender had been accepted and the verges had since been cut.
A question was presented to the PC asking why the Beak Hills Road does not get cut. This route has never been included in the contract, but it may need to be considered in future, if requested.
8. Motorcycles on bridleways around Raisdale and Fangdale – it was agreed that the ongoing issue of motorcycles would be monitored to see if it was worsening. No further reports have been received from NYP or the Rangers in connection to this issue.
9. Highways – It was noted that no further responses or reports had been received by the PC regarding the drainage and verges relative to Raisdale Road, Beak Hills, and Town Green. On-going monitoring of the areas of concern will continue and a walked survey will be retraced.
10. Finance:
The financial report and projected forecast were presented and explained. No payments had come out of the bank account since the last meeting.
Donations to local business and charities – RESOLVED it was agreed that the donations would be repeated as per the year 2020-21 apart from Chop Gate Primary School which

would get double the amount. This was due to the payment being missed last year due to missing bank payment details.

11. AGM – the date of the AGM is to be finalized. RESOLVED – Clerk to finalise a date as soon as possible but a minimum of 2 weeks' notice should be given.
12. New Correspondence – Grievance policy and complaints procedure to be reviewed and finalized at the next meeting.
13. The date of the next meeting is confirmed as Wednesday 1st September 2021 to be held within the village hall at 7.00pm.
